County Payments SRS was re-authorized for 2014-15 and 2015-16. The County will do a supplemental budget process when these funds are received to appropriate the revenue and expense. The Schools and Cities will receive a share of the funds per the formula adopted by the County in 2013-14. The P.E.T. funding has not been re-authorized therefore the budget reflects the reduction in revenue within the General Fund. The Health Department services continue to be contracted by Community Counseling Solutions and therefore the budget shows the state and federal pass through money. The Commission on Children & Families budget balance will be transferred to the Educational Service District for program distribution until the funds have been exhausted. The Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) grant has been applied for with the award to be determined in September 2015. The County has budgeted for a fulltime Human Resources position. The County and Circuit Court formed a financial partnership to install an elevator and replace all of the flooring on the top floor of the courthouse. The elevator and flooring projects are scheduled to be completed by June 2015. The District Attorney and Watermaster's office remodels are complete. The Fair is continuing fund raising efforts for the PA system and reader boards at the fairgrounds.
