Public Notice NUISANCE TO PUBLIC SAFETY AND WELFARE Ordinance 8.05.060 (6)

"No owner or person in charge of property may allow noxious vegetation to be on the property. It shall be the duty of an owner or person in charge of property to cut down or to destroy grass, shrubbery, brush and bushes, to prevent them from becoming a fire hazard, or, in the case of weeds or other noxious vegetation, from maturing or from going to seed. All lots less than one acre shall be maintained completely free of dry grass and weeds that may constitute a fire hazard. In addition, lots one acre or more in area may be required to maintain a twenty (20) foot fire break around the perimeter of the lot that is clear of all dry grass and weeds. The entire property must be free of noxious weeds as defined by the Grant County noxious weeds list. If the owner or person in control of the property is unwilling to abate the nuisance, the City shall cause such abatement in 10 or more days after notification by mail of said nuisance and charge the cost of doing so on any particular parcel or property to the owner thereof, or the property itself."

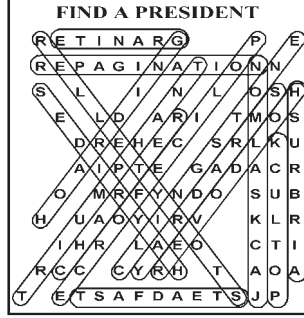
