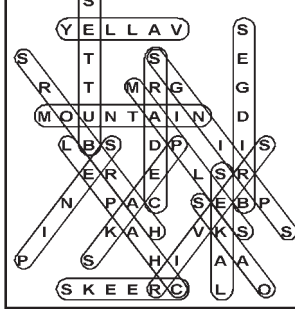

T-11840 filed by Darrel Holliday, 65126 Hwy 26, John Day, OR, 97845, proposes changes in points of diversion and place of use under Certificates 85323 and 85454. Certificates 85323 and 85454 both allow the use of 1/40 cubic foot per second (cfs) per acre irrigated to June 1 and 1/80 cfs per acre thereafter; further limited to 1.0 acre-foot per calendar month to June 1 and 4.0 acre-feet per acre during season April 1 to September 30; both from diversions on Indian Creek, located within Sects. 19 and 29; T13S, R33E, WM, for irrigation in Sects. 18 and 19. The applicant proposes to move the point of diversion to within Sec. 19. The applicant also proposes to move a portion of Certificate 85323 within Sec. 18. Ballot Title Caption: ALLOWS MARIJUANA ACTIVITIES MADE LEGAL BY OREGON IN GRANT COUNTY

Question: Shall the people of Grant County be permitted to engage in all legal marijuana uses and activities under state law?

Summary: This Measure would overturn Grant County Ordinance #2015-01. By overturning Grant County Ordinance #2015-01, the people of Grant County would be allowed to avail themselves to existing Oregon law which permits the production, cultivation, licensed processing, wholesaling, retailing and testing of marijuana.

The effective date of the measure would be 30 days after the day on which it is enacted or approved by a majority of the votes cast thereon.
