dying physical defects of confirmation in animals such as lifting or filling under the skin will be considered as fraud and deception. All animals giving evidence of such treatment before or after slaughter will result in the owner being barred from future shows and all awards and sale proceeds being withheld from the current show.

7. Judges may ask questions about the member's animal, fitting and showing.

8. ALL EXHIBITORS ARE AUTOMATICALLY ENTERED AND MUST EXHIBIT IN THE SHOWMANSHIP CONTEST UNLESS THEY HAVE BEEN EXCUSED BY THEIR RESPECTIVE BARN SU-PERINTENDENTS AND THE 4-H LEADERS EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE AND FFA INSTRUCTORS.

9. Showmanship class order will be Seniors first, Intermediates second and Juniors last.

10. Showmanship champions are eligible to compete in the Master Showmanship Contest If a member qualifies in two species (or more) he or she must choose which animal species they prefer to show. Those members who qualify for the Master Showmanship Contest (including small animals and horses) will use the animal they qualified with and start the contest with their own animal. Organization of the contest is at the discretion of the livestock superintendents, the Extension Agent and the FFA Instructors.

Τ. Stock may be sold in the barns only if approved by the appropriate barn superintendent. The 4-H program is NOT responsible for animals sold outside the auction; the transaction is between the seller and buyer.

U. During and at the conclusion of the Fair, straw and manure must be removed from the stall area to an area designated by the barn superintendent

V. 4-H exhibitors must at all times give the necessary personal attention to their exhibit and at the close of Fair must take entire charge of same. including cleaning of stalls and pens. There will be a financial penalty for those not cleaning their pens after the Fair, as per Fair newsletter.

W Bedding may be furnished and may be allotted according to animals listed on entry form. Exhibitors are to furnish feed for their own animals.

Exhibitors not cooperating with their su-X. perintendent or not taking proper care of their animals may be asked to take their animals home early.
