

### **Legal Notice Bridge Creek Prescribed Fire Project** 30-Day Scoping Period

The Prairie City Ranger District of the Malheur National Forest would like to invite the public to participate in planning for the Bridge Creek Prescribed Fire Project. We are asking for public scoping comments on the proposed action. The Malheur National Forest is proposing to prescribe burn approximately 17,100 acres within the Bridge Creek watershed. These actions are proposed within the Prairie City Ranger District portion of the Clear Creek, Dry Fork, and Wiwaanaytt Creek subwatersheds. Written comments shall include your name, address, and (if possible) telephone number, organization represented if any, title of document for which comment is being submitted, and specific facts or comments along with supporting reasons that you believe the Responsible Official should consider in reaching a decision. Electronic comr must be submitted in a format such as an email message, plain text (.txt), rich text format (.rtf), Word (.doc), or portable document format (.pdf). Email electronic comments to comments-pacificnorthwest-malheur-prairiecity@fs.fed.us. For electronically mailed comments, the sender should normally receive an automated electronic acknowledgement from the agency as confirmation of receipt. If the sender does not receive an automated acknowledgment of the receipt of the comment, it is the sender's responsibility to ensure timely receipt by other means. Emails submitted to e-mail addresses other than the one listed above, in other formats than those listed, or containing viruses will be rejected. Names and contact information submitted with comments will become part of the public record and may be released under the Freedom of Information Act. It is the responsibility of persons providing comments to submit them by the close of the comment period and ensure that their comments have been received.


