With a history that extends back to the 70s, the agency also has offices in Morrow, Gilliam and Wheeler counties with additional locations providing developmental disability (DD) case management services.

Private insurance and the Oregon Health Plan are accepted as well as a sliding scale plan for private-pay individuals.
