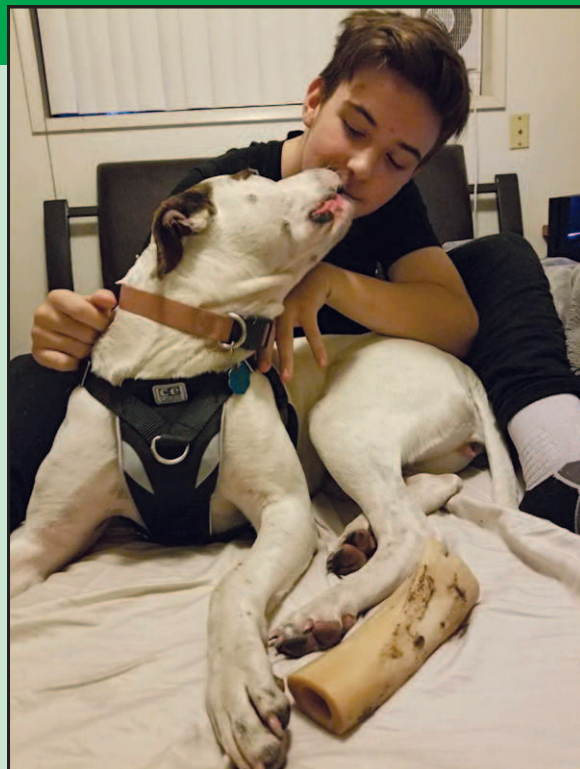

*Our volunteers:*

- Rescue and foster stray and abandoned dogs and cats, ensuring they get veterinary care and assessment for adoption.
- Partner with local veterinarians to save adoptable pets that face euthanasia because their owners can no longer care for them.
- Transport adoptable pets to partner agencies in other areas where larger population means a better chance of successful adoption into forever homes.
- Promote spay and neuter of pets through discount vouchers that pet owners can redeem at our local veterinary clinics.
- Conduct trap-neuter-return to control feral cat colonies, and offer food assistance through our Community Cats program.
