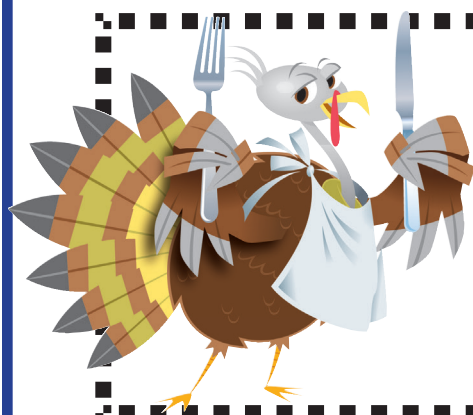
The Elks are committed to their mission, ***"So long as there are veterans, the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks will never forget them."***

John Day Lodge hosts group counseling for Veterans with PTSD every Wednesday!! "Counseling helps reduce veterans suicide rates"

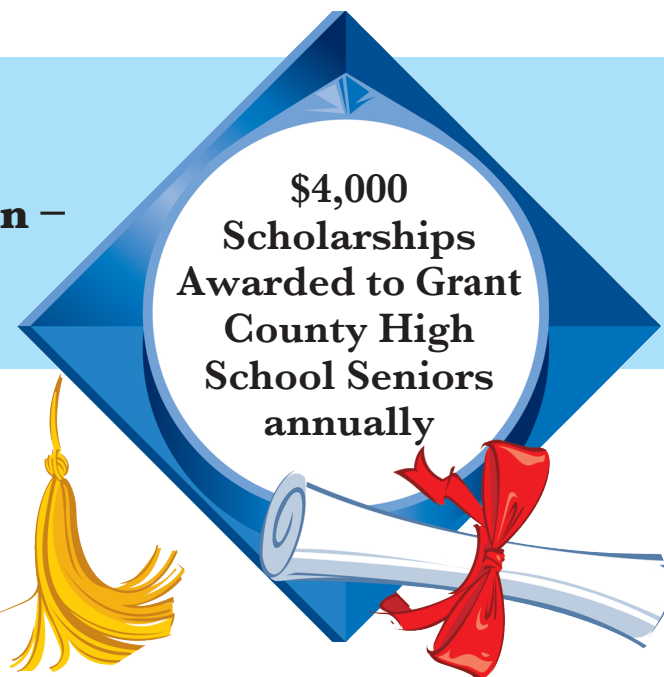
