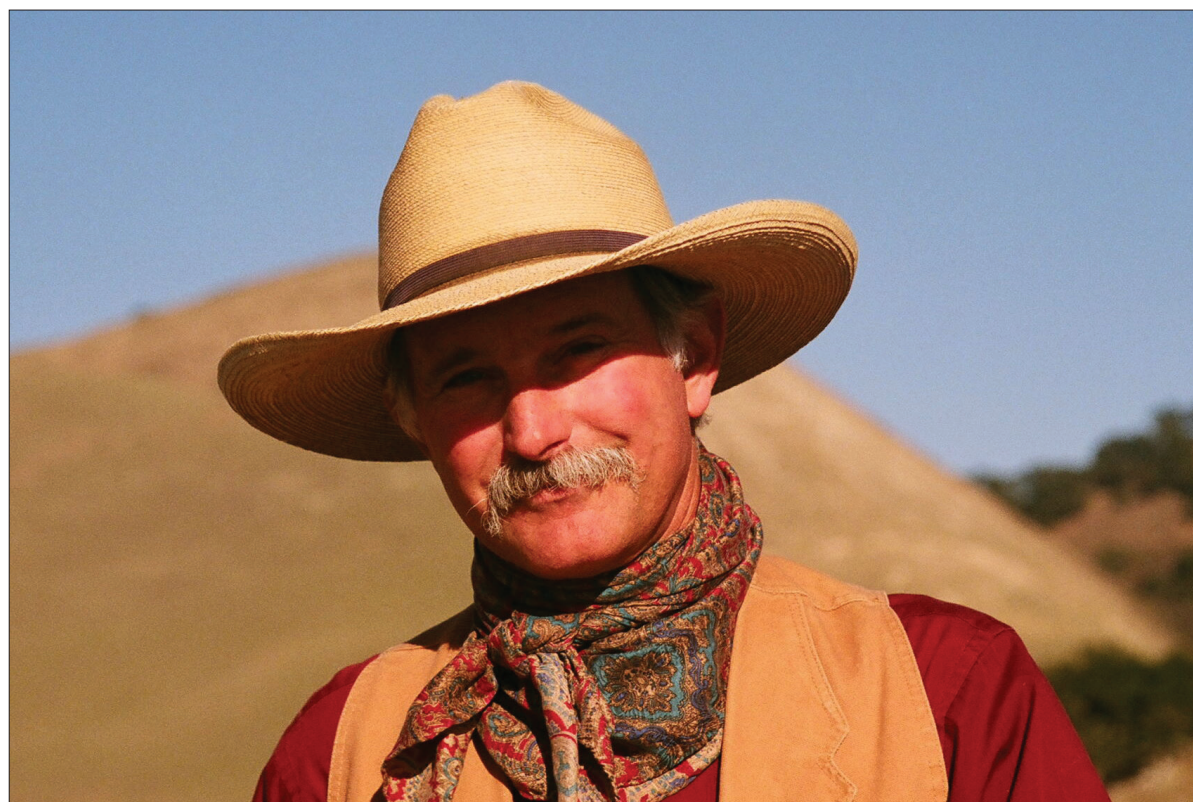
The OK Theatre and Mule Days organizers bring back one of Wallowa County's favorite entertainers to the fairgrounds lawn, where music lovers can enjoy the show while maintaining social distancing.

Gates open at 5 p.m. and the music begins at 6 p.m. Concertgoers are encouraged to bring

a lawn chair and come early to get a good seat on the lawn. To further safety efforts, masks are required.

Dave Stamey has been a cowboy, a mule packer and a dude wrangler, and he is now a popular Western entertainer. He was voted "Entertainer of the Year" and "Male Performer of the Year" seven times as well as "Songwriter of the Year" five times by the Western Music Association. He has also received the Will Rogers Award from the Academy of Western Artists.
