# KURZGESAGT

hen the coronavirus was ramping up in 2020, I searched online for something to explain just what the virus did to the human body. That's how I happened upon the works of German animation studio Kurzgesagt - German for "in a nutshell," or something similar.

Kurzgesagt uses a twodimensional, bright, minimalist style of animation with a British narrator in videos usually no more than 15 minutes long to explain and discuss subjects from the natural world to politics to technology. Kurzgesagt's video on COVID-19 helped me understand just how dangerous the disease could be.

Somehow, that cheery animation with the calming tones of a British accent made the worst effects of COVID-19 more terrifying.

From there, I was hooked on Kurzgesagt's work. Yes, I did want to know how big the biggest star is (yeah, our sun is a

Now, Kurzgesagt's early work sometimes had fact-checking issues, a situation the studio has worked to remedy, even going so far as to delete videos that no longer meet its standard for providing accurate information.
