JOB ANNOUNCEMENT

City of John Day seeks a city manager who is an established leader, understands all aspects of municipal government, and has an appreciation of the challenges facing small rural cities. The city manager supervises 16 employees and multiple contracted services. The city manager is the administrative head of the City and is responsible to the council.

The city manager will be paid an annual salary of \$80,000 to \$125,000 (DOQ), plus benefits. The city manager must have a bachelor's degree or combination of skills, training, and five years public or municipal administration experience; Master's of Public or Business Administration is preferred. Managerial and leadership experience is essential, preferably with a well-rounded background that includes a combination of public and private sector experience. Highly developed communication skills and experience working closely with elected officials is crucial as is a background in facilitation and conflict management. An exceptional ability to collaborate and develop effective community partnerships is required.

An essential function of the position requires access and use of certain confidential and sensitive financial information not customarily provided in a retail transaction (that is not a loan or extension of credit). In addition, the city may be required to obtain credit history information as a condition of bonding or insuring the city manager. The city's obtainment and review of an applicant's credit history, background, and/or criminal investigation reports is substantially job-related. Any offer of employment will be contingent on the applicant passing a credit history, background, and/or criminal history investigation.
