

# Inaugural Chautauqua Music Festival coming to Richland

**R**ICHLAND — The Eagle Valley Locals want to share their part of the world, and what better way than hosting a music festival?

The inaugural Chautauqua Music Festival is happening May 20-22 at Eagle Valley Grange Park. Featured bands are Tiller's Folly, Juni Fisher, The Wasteland Kings, Carter Junction, and JJQ (Jenni, Jon and Quinn).

In addition to music, the park will be filled with vendors. Of-

ferings so far will include food stands — barbecue, gourmet hot dogs, coffee, desserts — as well as artisans. A "local crafter's booth" will be available to those who have local products but not enough supply for their own stand.
