Miles received a bachelor's degree in philosophy from Saint Louis University and took both her master's and doctorate in English from the University of Delaware.

A longtime editor of Hawk & Hand-

aw, Miles served as a professor of environmental studies and writing at Maine's Unity College from 2001-2015 and has since taught in several graduate schools and low residency-MFA programs including, most recently, at Green Mountain College, in Vermont, where she was also writer-in-residence.

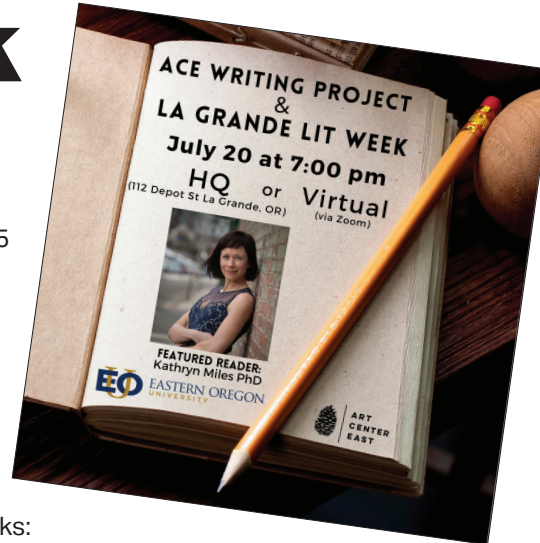

Her essays and articles have appeared in publications including Audubon, Best American Essays, The Boston Globe, Down East, Ecotone, History, The New York Times, Outside, Pacific Standard, Politico, Popular Mechanics and Time.

She currently serves as a scholar-in-residence for the Maine Humanities Council, a faculty member for several MFA programs, and as a private
