Crash: Driver held on \$500,000 bail

raigned Monday afternoon in Clatsop County Circuit Court. She faces six felony counts and one misdemeanor. Bail was set at \$500,000 with a preliminary hearing or grand jury indictment for Monday, Oct. 9.

She is charged with first-degree manslaughter, second-degree assault, third-degree assault, felony strangulation, two counts of felony hit and run and driving under the influence of intoxicants. If convicted, Barnett faces more than 10 years in prison.

Seaside police received a report of a woman being assaulted about 9:15 p.m. Saturday. As officers arrived at the scene, a woman leaving the area in a silver Dodge Durango struck one of the police cars and continued driving, according to state police.

As officers were looking for the vehicle, they came upon the bus stand in front of Me-

The vehicle had continued north on Roosevelt/Highway 101 and jumped another sidewalk, coming to rest after hitting a lamppost.

The driver, later identified

as Barnett, was walking away from the scene as police arrived. Witnesses identified her as the driver and she was arrested.

Barnett was treated for minor injuries at CMH and released to police custody a short time later.
