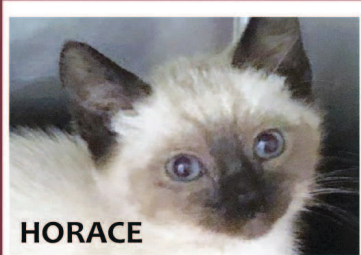

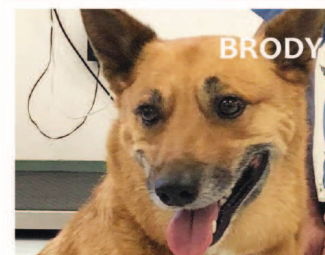

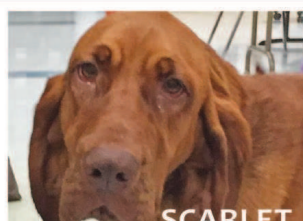

Hospital CEO named rural star

Erik Thorsen, chief executive officer of Columbia Memorial Hospital, was named a "2017 Community Star" by the National Organization of State Offices of Rural Health.

His story is among those featured during National Rural Health Day, which takes place on the third Thursday in November. The day is an annual recognition of medical professionals who serve the health needs of more than 60 million people living in rural communities in the United States, estimated to be 1 in 5 people.

The health leaders are nominated by the state Office of Rural Health. They include hospital and emergency first-responder teams, and community health and volunteer service practitioners who make a positive impact on those living in rural areas.
