A water tender carries a supply of water to a fire or emergency scene to augment

the limited water that's carried on a pumper or fire engine. The new tender will carry 3,000 gallons of water, have a 750 gallon-per-minute

pump and carry a portable water tank, along with other supporting equipment.

Now a second committee with Watson, Capt. Willie Nyberg, Lt. Derek Daugherty and firefighter Brian Alsbury are designing the tender's specifications and will attempt to find the right company to build it.

The tender will serve both the city and Warrenton Rural Fire District. It's expected to arrive by the end of summer 2018.
