Dump surplus drugs at take-back event

A drug take-back event is set for 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Saturday, April 28, at Warrenton Police Department. The agency is partnering with Clatsop County Health and the Drug Enforcement Administration for the 15th annual National Drug Take-Back Day. The agency plans a drive-up service on Second Street alongside City Hall, where a disposal box will be brought to you, Chief Matt Workman said. The event provides a solution for those who can't come in during business hours to put the medication in drop boxes at the four police stations: Astoria, Cannon Beach, Seaside and Warrenton. The boxes are inside and generally available only during business hours. Safe disposal prevents accidents with children, keeps others from stealing your medications and keeps the environment free from improperly disposed medication, Workman said.

Required boat-safety class is Friday

A mandatory boater education class will be held Friday, April 27, and a more in-depth class on safely crossing the Columbia and Tillamook bars is scheduled next month. The mandatory class, which all boaters must take, is from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. at First Baptist Church of Warrenton, 30 N.E. First St. Cost is \$10, which includes the class manual. Both courses are sponsored by USCG Auxiliary Flotilla 62 in partnership with the Oregon State Marine Board. The mandatory course covers practical boating safety information and local boating rules and regulations, tips and techniques for making boating more enjoyable, and cold-water survival skills. Students who successfully complete the course may apply for their boater education card.
