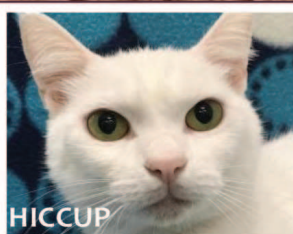

pect that will continue to be an issue. Public safety is the most important issue, that and affordable housing and jobs.”

He thanked his family and David Kelly, who helped with the campaign.

Kujala will be sworn in during the Board of Commissioners' first meeting in January, along with Lianne Thompson, who retained her District 5 seat with 59 percent of the vote, and whoever wins the District 3 seat after November's run-off between Pamela Wev and Peter Roscoe.

When Kujala stepped down from the mayor's post in 2017, he said he needed to spend more time with his family and business.

“I really enjoyed being mayor,” he said. But he took on a lot. There were weekly public coffees, a weekly column in The Columbia Press, work on city, county and state committees, a new baby.

“There came a point when I had to step away,” he said.

Joining the Board of Commissioners race was a decision he and his wife made together.
