Savings: State nudges workers to save

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While OregonSaves is making a dent in retirement insecurity, many employees still lack retirement plans. About 20 percent of respondents said a program isn't available through their workplace.

The state is requiring employers who don't offer a plan to facilitate OregonSaves through a "rolling" enrollment schedule starting with the largest employers first.

More than three-quarters of those taking the survey said they're concerned that some Oregonians haven't saved for retirement and could become reliant on public assistance programs.
