
## States allow two days for sturgeon

Anglers will have two days to get out on the Columbia River to catch and retain white sturgeon under rules approved last week by the Oregon and Washington departments of fish and wildlife.

The two-day recreational fishery is Sept. 15 and 22.

The white sturgeon season is about two weeks earlier than last year, when inclement weather impacted success rates and overall harvest.

Fishers are expected to catch 1,231 fish in the two days.
