## Dog enthusiasts can check out agility event

Classy Canines 4-H Club will have its annual public-participation dog recreational agility event (or Dog R.A.C.E.) on Saturday, Nov. 17, at the Clatsop County Fair & Expo Center arena.

The event gives dogs and their owners a chance to try beginning-level agility course.

There also will be an opportunity to test for the American Kennel Club Canine Good Citizen or Trick Title certification.

Spectators are welcome to watch the dogs learn to navigate the obstacle courses.
