Dog enthusiasts can check out agility event

Classy Canines 4-H Club will have its annual public-participation dog recreational agility event (or Dog R.A.C.E.) on Saturday, Nov. 17, at the Clatsop County Fair & Expo Center arena.

The event gives dogs and their owners a chance to try beginning-level agility course.

There also will be an opportunity to test for the American Kennel Club Canine Good Citizen or Trick Title certification.

The day starts with a mandatory registration and orientation at 8 a.m., followed by a free “Introduction to Jumpers with Weaves” workshop.

After the workshop, participants have an opportunity to compete in a jumpers with weaves competition for \$3.

An Introduction to Agility Contacts will follow with a touch-and-go competition for \$3. The last event is a standard agility fun run competition for \$3.

No previous experience is needed. Participants are asked to help put equipment away at the end of the day.

Those interested should bring a dog, a kennel or crate, a nontightening collar or harness, a 6-foot leash, many tiny soft treats, a water bowl and plastic clean-up bags. The arena is usually cold in the morning, so dress in layers and wear shoes that you can run in.

Spectators are welcome to watch the dogs learn to navigate the obstacle courses.
