Notice of Pending Type II Administrative Decision

John & Tracy Wilson of Hammond has submitted a request for a development code interpretation to allow a narrower setback in a Commercial Mixed Use zone as part of a lot line adjustment request. The subject property is located at 1120 Pacific Drive and 695-697 King Salmon Place and is identified as Tax Lot 81008BA00800.

The application file is available for public review until May 21, 2019 with an administrative decision to be made after the close of the review and comment period. Applicable Warrenton Municipal Code criteria include Chapter 16.44 Commercial Mixed Use, Chapter 16.236 Code Interpretations and Section 16.208.040 Type II Administrative Decisions Procedures.

All evidence to be relied upon to make a decision on this application is in the public record and available for review at the Warrenton Building and Planning Department, 225 S. Main Ave., Warrenton, at no cost. Copies can be made at reasonable cost. Following the close of the comment period, the Community Development Director shall issue a Type II Administrative Decision which will be mailed to the applicant and all parties who submit written comments or who are otherwise legally entitled to notice.

Failure to participate in this administrative review in writing or failure to address relevant issues with sufficient specificity may preclude your right to appeal the administrative decision on this application.
