The first, a 3.5-mile Coffenburg Lake hike led by Fort Stevens State Park Ranger Dane Osis, will take participants around the forested areas of the lake and through the dunes near DeLaura Beach. Hikers should meet in the North Coffenburg parking area at 9:30 a.m. Saturday, Aug. 17.

Doing paddle on Founders Day

Lewis and Clark National Historical Park will celebrate Founders Day with a paddling event from 5 to 7 p.m. Saturday, Aug. 24.

Founders Day celebrates the establishment of the National Park Service on Aug. 25, 1916.

Participants in Paddle Quest will paddle along the Lewis and Clark River and find clues to solve a puzzle. After the paddle, ecologist Tara Chestnut will talk about bats of the northwest.

The quest starts and ends

at the Netul Landing kayak launch, one and a half miles south of the Fort Clatsop visitor center.

Visitors will meet with a park ranger at the kayak launch area for orientation and directions.

All participants must wear a personal flotation device while on the water and bring their own paddling craft. A change of clothing and drinking water are recommended.
