Civil War re-enactors take over fairgrounds

President Abraham Lincoln and Gen. Ulysses S. Grant are expected to make an appearance at the annual "Battle for Clatsop County," a civil war re-enactment experience held throughout Labor Day weekend.

There will be authentic battles and an encampment, giving attendees a chance

to see what life was like in the early 1860s. The event is sponsored by the Northwest Civil War Council.

Hours are 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturday and Sunday and from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. Labor Day at the Clatsop County Fairgrounds, 92937 Walluski Loop, Astoria. Battles are at 11 a.m. and 3 p.m. on Satur-

day and Sunday, and at noon on Monday.

Admission is \$8 for adults, \$5 for seniors, members of the military and kids ages 6 to 12, and free for those 5 and younger. Parking is \$5.
