ball games. She even had a parent from an opposing team tell her she planned to take the idea back to her town so their sports boosters could raise money with no longer usable items. One of the jerseys was purchased by a former Warrenton High School football player who lives in New Jersey. He donated \$50.

"People didn't even know

they wanted one, but when they got done talking to me, they had to buy two," joked Lula Carlton.

Vice Principal Ian O'Brien liked the idea so much that when another bag filled with old jerseys was found, he made sure it was passed along to Kirby and her crew.

O'Brien, who doubles as athletic director, said the football team used some
