Homeless man attacked with hatchet

A homeless man who lives in a camp behind Goodwill was seriously injured when he was attacked by someone wielding a hatchet.

The name of the 50-year-old victim was withheld for his privacy, police said. He was taken to Columbia Memorial Hospital following the attack, which occurred about 10 p.m. Aug. 28.

He was found in the parking lot near AutoZone with a serious head injury.

Eventually he was transferred to a Portland hospital because of the severity of his injuries. He is expected to survive.

The Clatsop County Major Crime Team was activated and is in charge of the investigation, Warrenton Police Chief Matt Workman said.

During the initial investigation, a man who is not believed to be connected to the case, was arrested on an existing felony warrant for probation violation.

"Currently, investigators have no reason to believe there is a threat to the general public," Workman said.
