Urban renewal: Three projects in the works

Continued from Page 1 maining to be funded.

More than \$150,000 has been committed to the food court project, where it's hoped much of the work can be completed by city staff with city equipment.

A new water meter was installed on site recently, and staff members are working on plans for a sewer dump sta-

tion, Stelzig said. Initial plans are to pave just half the gravel lot – where the food trucks would go – so that future utility work won't require digging up the pavement.

Commissioner Mark Baldwin suggested the city do what it can as quickly as it can. "It's not going to get cheaper," Baldwin said.

"We are moving forward with these projects," City Manager Linda Engbretson said. "There's a lot of details and a lot of pieces."

In other action, the commission:

• Rejected a contractor's request for a noise variance. The contractor, who is working on the Clatsop County Jail project, had requested to begin work early on Oct. 5, 6 and 7. The city's code requires those using heavy construction equipment to begin work no earlier than 7 a.m. and the contractor had hoped to use a concrete pump truck beginning at 5 a.m.

• Signed an interim contract agreement with the city manager. Engbretson had requested to retire at the end of September, but has agreed to continue working on an interim basis until a new city manager is in place. Her interim contract would expire July 1, 2022.

• Hired PBS Engineering & Construction of Portland for \$128,600 to serve as design and engineering consultant for the work pier at Warrenton Marina.
