Quake tips on how soon and how big

Geologist Tom Horning will present a talk on "Preparing for Tsunamis: How Soon and How Big?" at 7 p.m. Tuesday, Oct. 12, in the Riverside Room at Seaside Civic and Convention Center, 415 First Ave.

The free event is presented by Seaside's CERT (Commu-

nity Emergency Response Team).

The familiar topic will have a twist as Horning talks about the geology of the Cascadia Subduction Zone in 2021. He'll talk about how earthquakes and tsunamis happen, how often they happen and how you, your family and the community can be better prepared. A question-and-answer session will follow the presentation.



Horning

Horning, a Seaside native, has a master's degree in geology from Oregon State University. After a career as an exploration geologist, he returned to Seaside in 1994 and became a

natural hazards and geotechnical consultant doing business as Horning Geosciences. He experienced the 1964 tsunami as a 10-year-old and is now active in trying to save lives in the tsunami

zones in and around Seaside.

There will be maps and materials to take home as well as an example of an easy-to-assemble grab-and-go bag. Additionally, the STARS Amateur Ham Radio Club will have a booth.
