SATURDAY, OCT. 30

Warrenton Fall Festival -- This large outdoor celebration of fall and Halloween is from 11 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. at Robinson Community Park, Fourth and Alder streets. It is sponsored by Spruce Up Warrenton and is free

In addition to a wrap-around-the-park trunk-or-treat, there will be a petting zoo sponsored by 4H, carnival games, a pumpkin patch, craft booths, food carts and hayrides.

The fire department may even have a pumpkin toss using a trebuchet.

Astoria Trick-or-Treat -- Astoria Downtown Historic District Association is sponsoring trick or treating from 3 to 5 p.m.

To participate, children must wear a costume and a face covering. Participating shops will have a sign out in front.

Halloween Happenings -- Seaside Downtown Development Association sponsors the annual two-day event with most merchants participating.

Today is a pet parade at 10 a.m., carnival booths on upper Broadway from noon to 3 p.m., a giant pumpkin

drop near the Turnaround at 3 p.m., and a trunk-or-treat from 4 to 5 p.m. on Broadway between Columbia Street and the Turnaround.

Boo Bash -- Emerald Heights, the large apartment complex at the east end of Astoria, is sponsoring its first ever Halloween party for all Clatsop County children.

There will be games, a costume contest, free school supplies and trick-or-treating.

The bash begins at 4 p.m. at the clubhouse, 1 Emerald

Drive.

Doggie Howloween -- If you don't mind a drive to Cathlamet, Wash., the Wahkiakum Chamber of Commerce is sponsoring dog-oriented events beginning at 1 p.m. in the covered area at Erickson City Park, off Columbia Street along the waterfront east of the bridge.

Included in the free event is a dog costume contest, doggy pie-eating contest, a pet psychic and a raffle benefitting WAAG, the local animal advocacy group.

Donations of canned pet food, blankets, newspaper or litter will be collected. All dogs must be on nonretractable leashes and up-to-date on vaccinations.

Trunk-or-Treat at Lighthouse Church -- The free event is open to the public from 4 to 6 p.m. and includes booths, games, trick-or-treating and a cake walk.

Today is a witches' paddle at 11:30 a.m. at Quatat Park, and trick-or-treating at downtown businesses (look for an orange pumpkin in the front windows) from 2 to 4 p.m.
