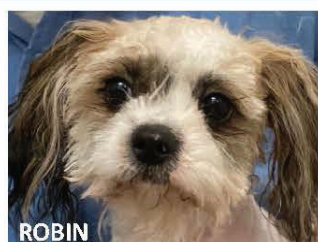

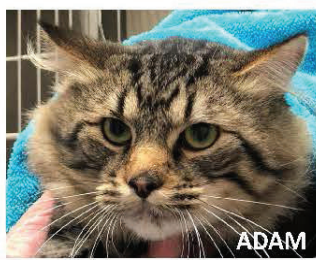

Hazardous waste day is Saturday

The Household Hazardous Waste collection center will be open from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Saturday, March 19, at the county's new facility at 1780 Williamsport Road, next to the Recology Western Oregon Waste transfer station.

The center is the result of several years of collaboration between Clatsop County, Recology, local cities, community organizations and the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality.

The facility provides a means for proper disposal of hazardous toxic wastes, including paint, fluorescent lights and light ballasts, cleaners, propane tanks, herbicides, antifreeze, motor oil, gasoline, fertilizers, aerosols, pesticides, batteries, and compressed gas cylinders.

Material not accepted includes unused medications, syringes, and asbestos.

Fire Department plans open house

Warrenton Fire Department hosts an open house from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Saturday, March 19, at the main fire station, 225 S. Main Ave.

The agency plans to announce its new Emergency Medical Services Division, primarily for those interested in working as a medic or other health worker.

The public is invited to meet some of the current members and get information about how to sign up. Medical training will be provided by the department. There also will be a physical ability demonstration.

Ninety percent of the fire department's emergency calls last year were medically related.
