## Teens can learn to forage for plants

Teenagers can learn to forage through the Lewis and Clark National Historical Park Klahowya Youth volunteer program.

The class is set for 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Saturday, May 21, at the South Netul Landing,

91427 Fort Clatsop Road, about a mile south of the Fort Clatsop Visitor Center.

The session is one of five living history workshops held this spring, with youth participants agreeing to demonstrate their new skills later during public sessions at the park.

Participants learn about native plants, their ecological and cultural importance, and how they can be used for consumption and medicine.
