Constitutional Amendments.

At the election on June 4, the electors are requested to vote on five different proposed amendments to the state constitution. The first on the ticket is "Municipal Indebtedness Amendment" which is in substance as follows:

"No county, city, town, school district or other municipal corporation shall be allowed to become indebted in any manner or for any purpose to any amount exceeding five per centum in the value of the taxable property therein, to be ascertained by the last assessment for state or county taxes previous to the incurring of such indebtedness."

The next one is the "Judiciary Amendment" which is as follows:

"The legislative assembly may provide

That the constitution be amended by adding Article 19, as follows:

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
