These pests will be identified by Prof. Cordley, entomologist at the State Agrultural College, who will be present and tell the farmers how to reognize the pests and how to successfully fight them. Thousands of boxes of fine apples and pears are annually lost in this county because the farmers do not know how to keep the pests off their trees. At these fruit growers meetings orchardists will get more practical knowledge and how to combat the pests than could be learned in six months spent in reading on the subject. It will pay every farmer who has even a dozen fruit trees to 'attend this meeting and learn how to grow fruit that will bring a profitable price in the marke instead of being only fit for hog feed.
