The adjourned term of County court convened Wednesday of this week and received two road petitions which will be acted upon at the next term in June.

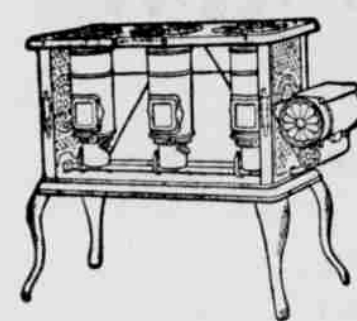
Ordered that the lower Sucker creek and the Illinois bridge between Kerby and Waldo be repaired and Commissioner Logan to oversee same.

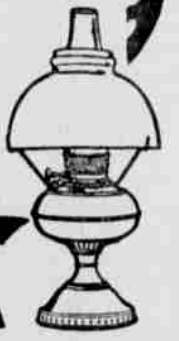
