Large Corps of Experts at Work in the Field Compiling Statistics.

The government has had a corps of investigators, statisticians, experts and scientists at work all summer taking an inventory of the natural resources of the United States.

The work taken up by Federal government has aroused the interest of the various states and state commissions are reporting to the national conservation commission at the rate of three or four a week and large national organizations are rapidly coming forward with conservation committees of their own.

The work of the National Conservation Commission will be of incalculable value and is the first step toward making provisions for future generations by taking care of the resources of the country.
