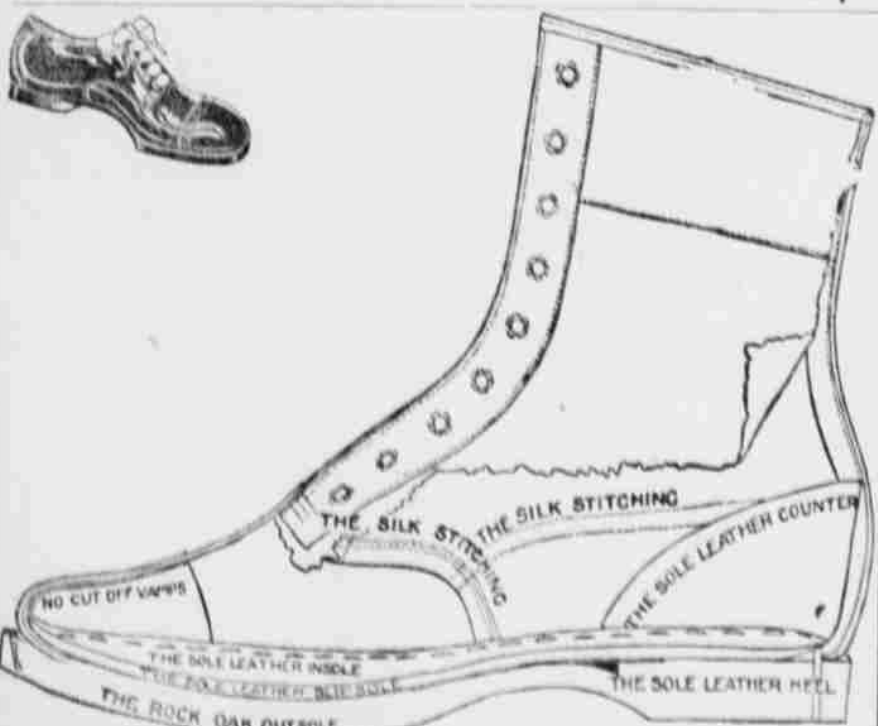

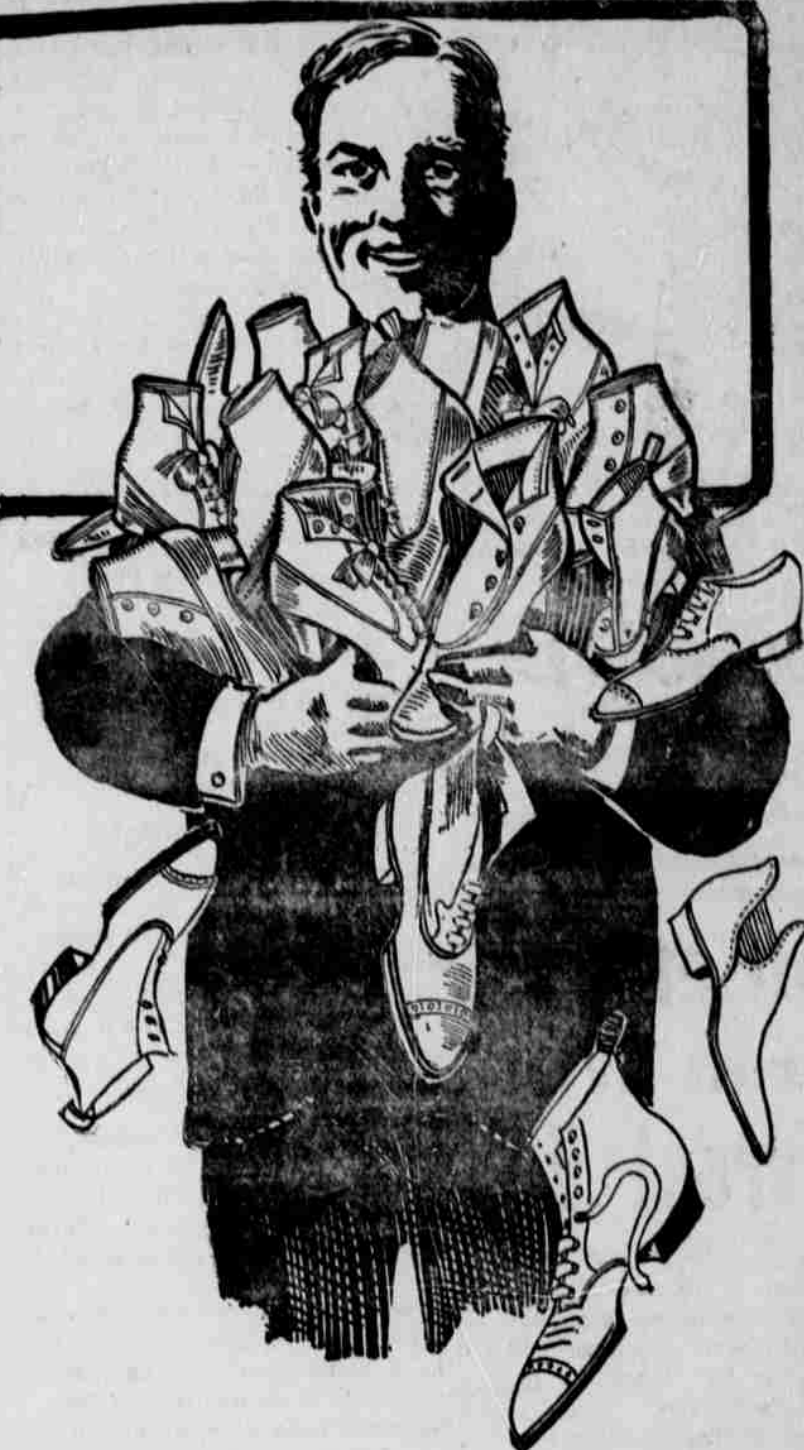
WILL BE DONATED TO THE PARK IMPROVEMENT FUND

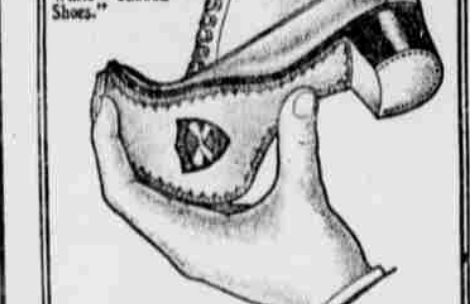

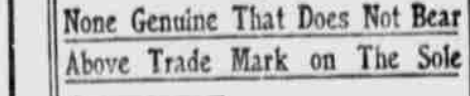
