The following proceedings were had to-wit: Statement of S. F. Cheshire, county clerk, in the matter of the issuance of county warrants for scalp bounties for and during the month of August, 1912, examined and approved.

In the matter of the petition of Malinda F. Cameron for a public easement road in Sec. 23, Twp. 36 S. R. 5 West; said petition was duly considered and the county board of road reviewers ordered to view, survey and lay out said road in accordance with the petition and make report in the matter at the October, 1912, term of the court.

In the matter of the resignation of Cora B. Lemon, county physician, said resignation was accepted by the court and Dr. J. G. Smith appointed instead to serve until January 1, 1913.

In the matter of the petition of E. L. Churchill and 175 others for a local option liquor election to be held in the city of Grants Pass, Oregon; said petition was granted and election ordered to be held November 5, 1912.

An appropriation of \$500 was made by the court for the benefit of the Second Annual Josephine County Grange Fair to be held at Grants Pass, Oregon, September 18th, 1912.
