Mr. and Mrs. Ed Mangini, who have been making their home at the O'Brien camp, left last Wednesday for Seattle where they will be for a short time.

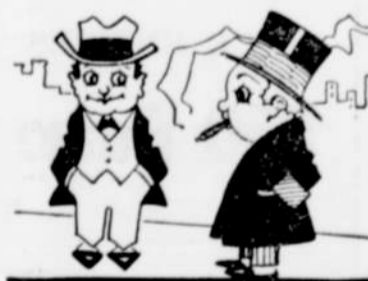
