National Forest Timber for Sale

Sealed bids will be received by the Forest Supervisor, Grants Pass, Oregon, up to and including August 1, 1940, for all the live timber designated for cutting, and all merchantable dead timber located on an area embracing about 420 acres within Section 34, T 36 S., R. 8 W., and Sections 4, 10, and 22, T. 37 S., R. 8 W., W. M., Swede Basin watershed, Siskiyou National Forest, Oregon, estimated to be 1,400,000 feet B. M. of sugar and ponderosa pine timber and 100,000 feet B. M. of Port Orford white-cedar timber, more or less. No bid of less than \$4.00 per M. feet for sugar and ponderosa pine and \$5.00 per M. feet for Port Orford white-cedar will be considered. \$1,500 must be deposited with each bid, to be applied on the purchase price, refunded damages, according to conditions of sale. The right to reject any and all bids is reserved. New Market For Oregon Grown Foods

All Oregon farmers will be interested in the Federal Food Stamp Plan. The stamp plan is designed to move surplus farm products by increasing the purchasing power of families on relief. The plan has been in successful operation in Multnomah county since January 1, 1940.

Statistics show that relief families spend an average of only four dollars per person per month for food. That's only five cents a meal (compared to 12 1-2c for non relief families) and is one of the major reasons why there is a food surplus on our farms. When city families can't buy food, farmers can't sell it.

The food stamp plan is one way in which the amount relief families spend for food can be increased. Families participating in the plan buy four to six dollar's worth of orange-colored food order stamps monthly for every member of the family. These stamps are used the same as cash in any market or retail food store in Multnomah county, and are good for any kind of food except wine, beer, liquor or tobacco.

This minimum purchase of \$4.00 is set so that relief families will continue to buy at least as much food as they have in the past. Then to increase the amount of food consumed, these families are given two dollars' worth of blue-colored

surplus food stamps free, with every four dollars worth of orange-colored food order stamps bought. These blue surplus food order stamps are spent in retail food stores for those foods that the secretary of agriculture has declared to exist in surplus quantities.

At present the surplus food list includes many Oregon grown products. The complete list is: butter, eggs, prunes, pears, apples, oranges, grapefruit, raisins, corn meal, hominy grits, rice, dried beans, wheat and graham flour, pork lard and pork. The secretary of agriculture, as you know, is constantly in touch with the crop and crop-surplus. As surpluses in the products now on the list are used up, they will be removed from the list. When surpluses may appear in other foods, they will be added to the surplus food list.

All residents of Multnomah county who are receiving public aid through the County Public Welfare Commission, Aid to Dependent Children, Old Age Assistance, Blind Aid, and those who are working on WPA projects, are eligible for participation in the Food Stamp Plan. This means a total of over 36,000 people eligible to buy the food stamps. Participation in the food stamp plan is entirely voluntary. Of those who are eligible to do so over 90 per cent actually participate and buy the stamps.

During the first 15 weeks the Multnomah county participants in the plan used over one million dollars worth of orange and blue stamps. This means that the Portland Food Stamp Plan participants will spend two and one-half million dollars' worth of food stamps a year on food, and one-third of this sum will be spent for the listed surplus foods only.

Yet, even this figure doesn't tell the entire story of the benefits to the Oregon farmer that the food stamp plan brings. With these surplus foods in demand by a quarter of a million people, the grocers are featuring them with advertising and special promotion. Mrs. Average Housewife is taking advantage of the special "buys" on them and that means an even wider market for farm produce.

As the retailers sell their supply of food, they'll call on the wholesalers or jobbers for more, and this increased demand should stabilize and strengthen farm prices. At the same time, the direct purchasing of surplus foods by the

federal government will continue for those cities in which the food stamp plan is not operating. Also, the free school lunch program will continue in all areas. Thus, the Federal Surplus Commodities Corporation of the department of Agriculture has a double-barrelled gun aimed at Oregon farm surpluses.

The food stamp plan will be extended into other Oregon counties that request it as soon as appropriations are available.

OSC Engineering School "Enlisted" for Defense

Oregon State College — The school of engineering will be busy this summer in a program of cooperation with the federal government on national defense, the full extent of which is not yet determined.

Already the department of mechanical engineering has been authorized to continue the pilot training course under the Civil Aeronautics administration. At least 50 new men will be accepted for training for a three months period starting about June 15. These men will be provided training without cost and will be given the same work for which a charge of \$40 was made this last year.

The college has also responded to a request to make available the facilities of the school of engineering in an extensive training program in connection with national defense measures in mechanical warfare. It is possible that

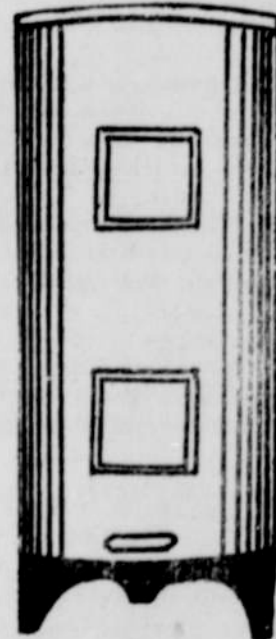
