S. P. TRAINS WILL CHANGE SCHEDULE

Schedules of Southern Pacific train the Shasta, will be changed effective Sunday, May 11, it was announced by the company today. To provide a more convenient evening departure, southbound train will leave Grants Pass at 4:45 p. m. instead of 4 p. m. and depart from other southern Oregon points approximately 45-minutes later than now applies, arriving San Francisco 8:50 a. m. next morning. The Shasta will operate as a through train between southern Oregon and San Francisco instead of being consolidated with the Klamath at Dunsuir, as was necessary during the winter months. Northbound schedule will be changed slightly. The train will leave San Francisco at 8:35 p. m. and arrive southern Oregon points approximately 20-minutes later than now, arriving Grants Pass at 12:01 p. m. instead of 11:40 a. m.

The new schedule and recent addition of a new de luxe, air-conditioned cafe-lounge car to the Shasta is expected to make the train more popular than ever with the traveler, it was stated.
