mous in its support of price controls. It has much to lose from inflation. . . ."

Commenting upon the board's action, Director Peterson pointed out that the opposition to consumer subsidies is not a request for any general rise in food prices. "Some upward adjustments are necessary but on relatively few items. Responsible agricultural representatives recognize that any

price program for agriculture must not be of a profiteering nature. They likewise recognize the need of support prices as a necessary incentive to increased production of some commodities, particularly where temporary acreage shifts are required. Any sound agricultural program must deal fairly with consumers. . . . Like all good business men they (the farmers) value consumer good will. They must, however, have at least cost of production in order to produce the food our government and our country needs. . . ."
