tion," the Public Health Service says.

Of the 12,000,000 homes that have to be served by private water supplies, 6,500,000 are without running water. The Public Health Service assumes that because of its inconvenience to the householder no home water supply that fails to be within 50 feet of the house is satisfactory.

The Public Health Service estimates that approximately 5,294,000 American rural homes should have improvements in their water supplies — improvements that on the average might cost \$50 a home.

A booklet, "Home Repair and Modernization," is intended to help the home owner go over all parts of his house, inside and out, and make a record of repairs and improvements that should be made. Copies are available from the Bureau of Foreign and Domestic Commerce, Washington, 25, D. C.
