FERTILIZER IS GOING TO BE SCARCE

Josephine county farmers will have to wait longer for their allotment of AAA phosphate this year and then it is probable that they will get less than was received this past year, according to word received from the State AAA office in Corvallis.

Jens F. Svinth, county horticultural agent, remarked that this was indeed unfortunate especially for those farmers making new ladino seedings or plantings of winter legumes for hay and green manure. Svinth advised that it would be advantageous for those farmers to place their orders for fertilizer with their dealers immediately. This would give the dealers a basis

It was also pointed out that in some instances phosphate applied at the proper time has doubled yields of hay and seed crops and should be used annually providing it can be obtained. Another factor to keep in mind is the refund payment made by the AAA for the use of phosphate on certain crops. This payment is made to AAA members regardless of where they obtained the phosphate, if receipts are retained to prove that it has been purchased and used.
