Now that Poppy Day is past and the poppy posters no longer will be needed for display, all those wishing their posters returned may get them by asking Mrs. Taylor at

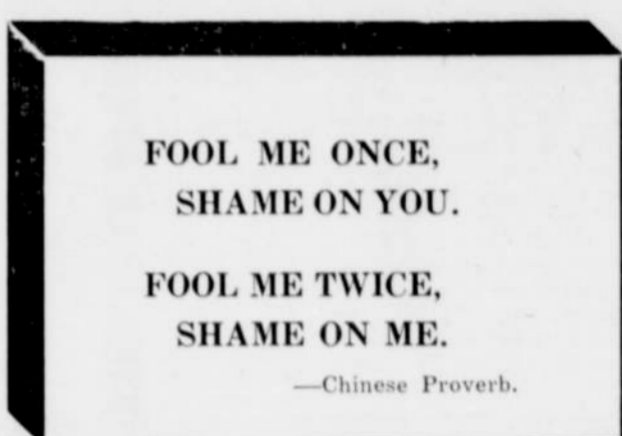
the theater. The Unit is very proud to know that the poster made by Charlotte King of Selma won honorable mention in the Department contest.

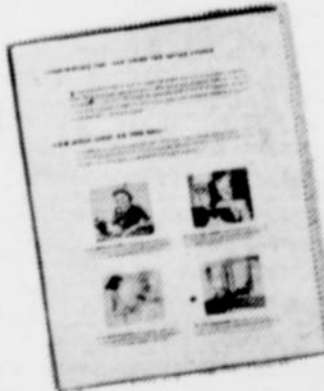
