John Reuben Tucker

John Reuben Tucker was born in Cottage Grove June 11 1881, and died at the Josephine General Hospital in Grants Pass, June 6, 1945.

He moved to the vicinity of Grants Pass in 1906, where he met Martha Breazeale and they were married October 1, 1908. Nine children were born, eight of whom are living. Mr. Tucker had lived in Selma for 34 years at the time of his death, which was caused by a truck accident.

He is survived by his wife, Martha B. Tucker; sons, Dale R., Loy A., Jay Z.; daughters, Mrs. Winnie Pickle, Mrs. Inez Hatmaker and Mrs. Ardith Stephens, all of Selma; Wm. J. Tucker of Roseville, Calif., and R. D. Tucker, serving in the navy. Two sisters survive, Mrs. Nancy Hervey of Grants Pass and Mrs. Myrtle Jones of Kennewick, Wash., and 26 grandchildren.

Funeral services were held Saturday, June 9, at the Selma church, with the Rev. Anderson officiating. Hull & Hull Funeral home were in charge of arrangements and interment was in the Deer Creek cemetery.

State Fair Planned For Next Year

The State Board of Agriculture decided recently against holding a State Fair in 1945, the last one being held in 1941.

The board gave the following reasons for not having it this year: Farmers have no time to prepare exhibits, a fair would impede harvesting of crops, the transportation problem is critical, and too much labor would be needed to make repairs at the fair grounds in Salem.

The board stated, however, that definite plans are being made for holding a fair in 1946.
