The Jap sat up, pulled the fuse on the grenade and held it against Lyons' stomach. The Jap was pushed aside by a Marine and ran from the cave. Outside he found to his horror that the grenade had caught in his shirt. He flicked it aside and hit the dirt just as the grenade went off. He was shaken but uninjured. A few seconds later he heard another sharp report in the cave. The Jap had blown himself to bits. Lyons, a veteran of three major campaigns also fought at Cape Gloucester and Peleliu.

Corporal Lyons is a brother of Mrs. Clarence Martin of Cave Junction.
