CROP PROSPECTS UP NATIONALLY, LOWER IN OREGON

(Editor's Note: The following review of the market crop, and outlook information is prepared weekly by the extension economist at Oregon State college from material obtained over a government leased wire, and other reliable state and national sources. It is not intended to replace daily market reports.)

Crop prospects declined in Oregon generally during July, although the weather was favorable in the nation as a whole, according to a weekly review by the O. S. C. Extension Service. Grain crop prospects fell sharply in Oregon but hay production it still expected to exceed last year.

National prospects for corn improved and the crop reporting service estimate was raised to 2,844 million bushels, 160 million more than the July 1 figure but still 12 per cent under the harvest of 1944. The percentage of soft corn probably will be considerably above average.

The national oats crop at 1,546 million bushels breaks the 25-year

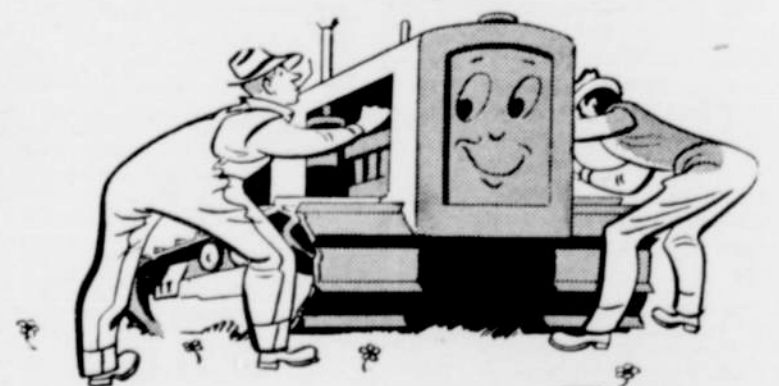
