M., for the purpose of submitting the following proposition to the legal voters residing in the boundaries described in the proposition:

"Shall that portion of Josephine County, Oregon, described as: Beginning at a point on the East fork of the Illinois River on the Quarter section line running North and South through the center of Section 21, run thence North along the said quarter section line to the center of Section 16, thence East along the center line running East and West through Section 16, to the old Crescent City road in Section 15, thence in a Southerly direction along the West boundary line of the old Crescent City road to a point which is 300 feet North of the present Oregon Caves Highway, thence Easterly and parallel with the said Oregon Caves Highway to a point on the section line between Sections 26 and 27, thence South 300 feet to the center of the said Oregon Caves Highway, thence continuing South 300 feet from the center line of said highway, thence in a Northwesterly direction and parallel with the said Oregon Caves Highway to a point which is 300 feet East of the old Crescent City road, thence Southwesterly and parallel with the old Crescent City road to the fork of the Illinois River, thence in a Northwesterly direction along the North bank of the Illinois River to the point of beginning, all in Township 39 South, Range 8 West of the Willamette Meridian, in Josephine County, Oregon.

**IMPORTANT NOTICE TO CAR OWNERS**

The Secretary of State makes the following statement, which all owners of motor vehicles should read carefully:

"Steel restrictions make it possible to furnish only ONE 1946 license plate. It must be placed on the REAR of your vehicle. A validating sticker is included in the white window envelope attached to your license plate. It must be placed on your right windshield behind the rearview mirror. License plates and sticker valid in 1945 must be removed.

**Darker Wheat Flour Also Richer, Claim**

The new order calling for 80 per cent extraction of flour from wheat will mean bread with higher vitamin and mineral content than at present, provided the present enrichment program is continued, says Dr. Margaret Fincke, head of foods and nutrition at Oregon State college. The bread will be slightly darker and will have a more wheaty flavor which some may prefer. Wholesale dealers expect the new flour to be on the market in about 30 days.

**GAS CONSUMPTION UP IN OREGON**

Gasoline consumption in Oregon for the year 1945 totaled 269,102,597 gallons, an increase of 16 percent over the consumption of 231,859,757 gallons reported in 1944, Secretary of State Robert S. Farrell Jr., disclosed today.

The 1945 total was greater than any year's use with the exception of 1941, when 297,966,614 gallons were used. The year 1941 was the peak year for motor vehicle use in this state.

Total taxes paid on the gasoline consumed in the state last year amounted to \$13,455,129.97, compared to \$11,592,988.02 a year ago.
