IRRIGATION DITCHES TO BE PROVIDED WITH FISH SCREENS

Quite a number of fish screens will be ready for installation in the irrigation ditches of the state as soon as weather conditions permit, reports C. A. Lockwood, in charge of the fishways and screens department of the Game Commission.

Already completed a re 25 screens for Baker county and 25 for Wallowa county which will be installed in the near future. Installations are being made now in Jackson and Josephine counties, and a crew is also being sent to check and repair screens in Deschutes county.

Attention to anglers planning to take advantage of the spring salmon runs in the Rogue and Umpqua rivers is called to the new regulation promulgated by the Commission at its January meeting to curb the practice of snagging. It is unlawful to use single hooks larger than one inch, or double or treble hooks larger than 3/4 of an inch, measured from the point of the hook to the shank. All sinkers or weights must have the place of nearest attachment in a position 18 inches or more above the hook or hooks.

Other sections of the state will be taken care of as rapidly as possible.

Are Your Children . . . Your Neighbor's Children

(who lived in the district Oct. 25, 1945)

Listed in the County School District Census?

Ages 4 years to 19 years inclusive.

(The school census determines the money received by the school district from: County School Fund, State School Fund, State School Support [income tax] Fund.)

The list now in the County School District office is fairly complete in so far as school age children are concerned . . .

However children born in 1940 and 1941 are entitled to be included in this census.

To date, 1st grade students, born in 1939, number 222. Only 112 children are listed as having a 1940 birthday; 77 listed as born in 1941.

Also those born in 1926, before October 25 and those born in 1927 are entitled to be on the census . . . in military service, married or out of county (but residence here) included.
